ISO 27002

ISO 27002 is an internationally recognized standard and a key source of guidance for information security management practices. It is high level, broad in scope, and conceptual in nature, and gives input for acceptable approaches to managing information security across eleven domains. Each domain identifies information security controls and specifies their objectives. Implementation guidance is provided for each control; however, no specific control is mandated by the standard.

According to ISO 27002, your organization is responsible for completing a structured information security risk assessment process to determine your information security needs and for selecting appropriate controls.

The ISO 27002 standard is applicable to all businesses and industries. As an international standard, it is recognized globally. Many laws and other standards have drawn from the ISO standard's best practices and controls as a foundation.
